Dear Colleague,

In consideration of your expertise and interest in the Gothenburg Review process, taking place in the frame of the UN-ECE LRTAP, it is our pleasure to invite you to participate in the 20<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Expert Group on Techno-Economic Issue (EGTEI), which will take place in Warsaw, on the 21<sup>st</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup> of November, 2011, hosted by the Polish EU Presidency. The outcome of the 49<sup>th</sup> Session of WGS&R, held in Geneva, last September, has more and more highlighted the crucial role of the EECCA Countries in achieving the final agreement on the revised Gothenburg Protocol.

Important issues, like the cooperation between EGTEI and the Coordinating Group on promotion of actions towards implementation of the LRTAP Convention in Eastern Europe, Caucasus and Central Asia (EECCA Coordinating group) and the Russian Federation, results of application of the EGTEI Cost Methodology, subject of a Pilot Study in cooperation with the Russian Federation, the progress in the work of the established sub-group of EGTEI, on emerging techniques 50 to 500 MW [EmTech50-500], the cooperation in progress with other relevant bodies of the Convention and other stakeholders, will be matter of discussion during the meeting in Warsaw. The meeting will start (tentatively) at 14:30 on the 21<sup>st</sup> of November (sub-group of EGTEI, on emerging techniques) and will continue with the plenary session on the 22<sup>nd</sup> of November, closing at (tentatively) 16:30. Looking forward to your envisaged participation.
