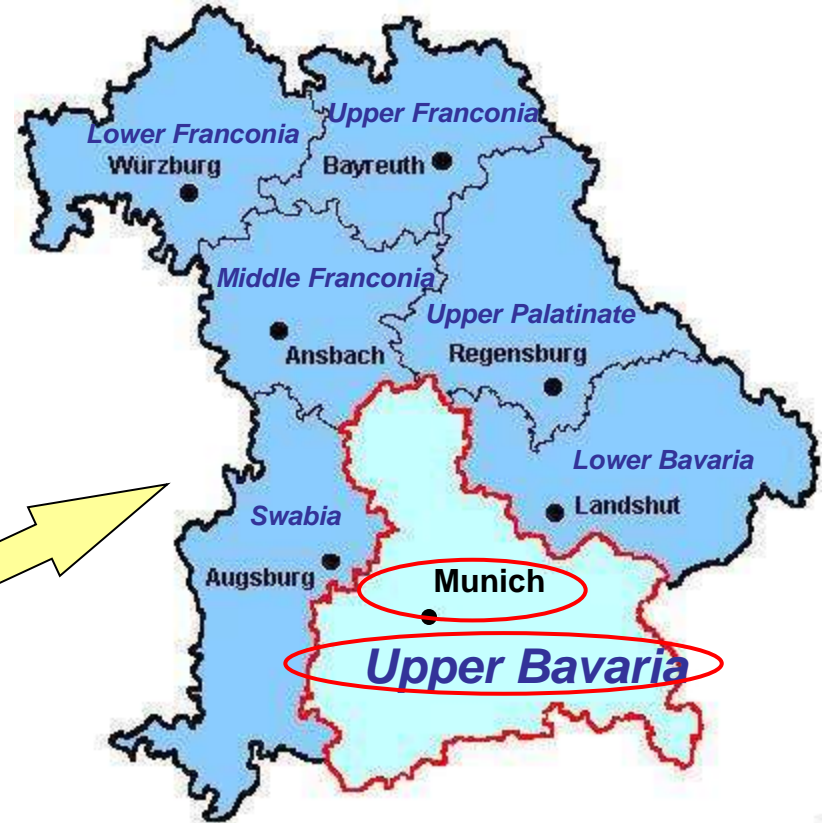
Republic of Bavaria is administratively structured in

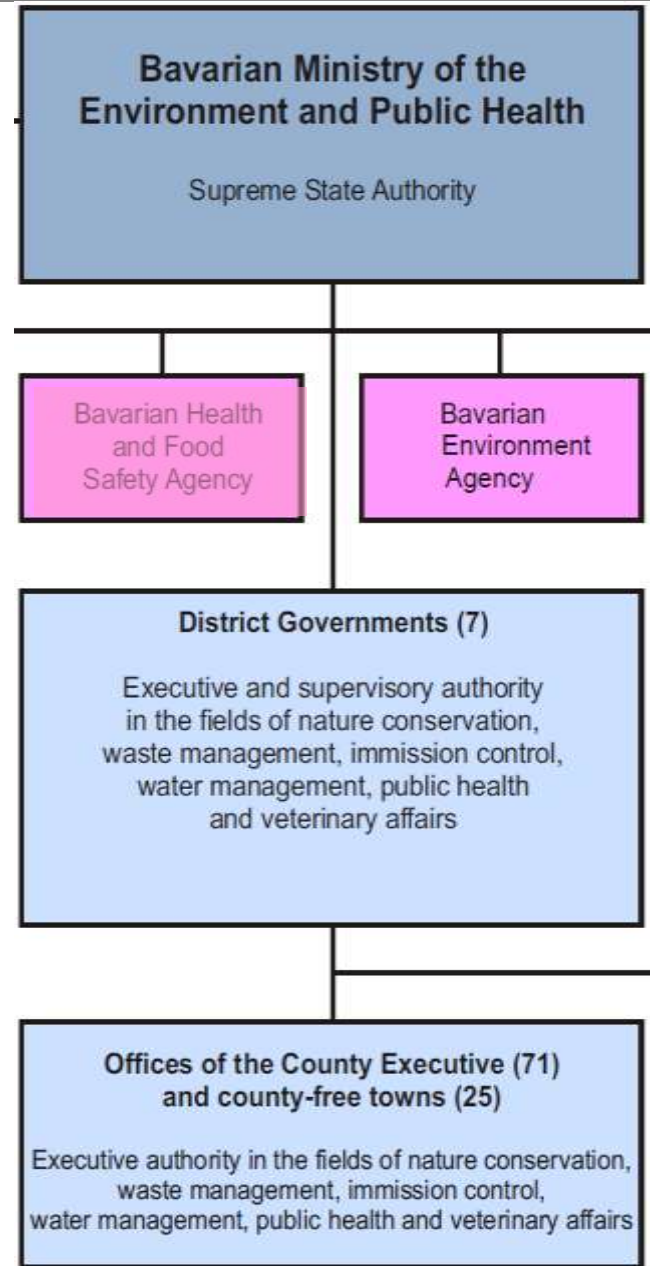
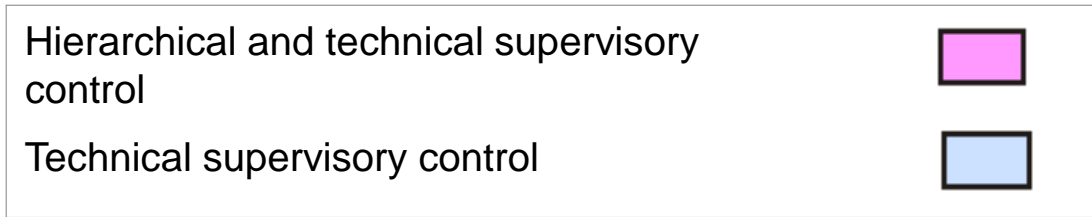

Competence

- hierarchical and technical supervisory control of lower levels of hierarchy
 - guidance of immission control
 - question of law / fundamental issues
 - very less execution tasks_
- **Staff**: approx. 15 scientists, engineers, lawyers

administrative structures referred

7 District Government

Competence

- executive authority especially for
 - waste incinerating plants and
 - power plants in order to public energy supply

Staff: approx. 35 engineers, scientists,
18 administration secretaries

administrative structures referred
to immission control

71 counties and 25 county-free towns (Σ 96)

Competence

➤ executive authority for all

other installations with integrated permits (approx. 10.000)

Staff: estimated 240 engineers and
120 administration secretaries
responsible for whole scope of immission control
