# Perspectives for the future work plan 2024-2025



Depending upon the decision of the EB, on the post review phase, at its 42<sup>nd</sup> session in December 2022, TFTEI could be involved in possible new challenging tasks:

- Revision of the Technical Annexes (whatever their nature will be in the future)
- Revision of the Guidance Documents on Stationary and Mobile Sources
- Other specific Guidance Documents

Along with the institutional tasks as in the revised mandate.
