Introduction

In recent years, the work of TFTEI has been characterized by the development of Guidance Documents concerning the most relevant subjects to provide techno-scientific support to the Parties, for the implementation of the Convention.

The Executive Body, at its 43rd session, in December 2023, is expected to take decisions on the future of the Gothenburg Protocol. The ongoing process might take a while before coming to possible agreed actions. Whatever the results will be, TFTEI believes that updated information, on the available technologies and their characteristics, will be beneficial for the Parties, in any case.

TFTEI Proposal

TFTEI proposes the *revision of the existing Guidance Documents related with Stationary Sources and the Mobile Sources*, independently from the AGP Annexes and their future role/evolution.

Considering the volume of documents to be revised (concerning 42 industrial sectors and all the mobile categories) and the need of consultations with experts, sector by sector, the revision of the Guidance Documents will take about one year and a half and, therefore, the work should start quickly.

One or more formal documents would be the final delivery *in 2025* (directions from the UN-ECE Secretariat are needed).
