

- World Bank AQM Programme in the Indo-Gangetic Plain Himalayan Foothills area (IGP-HF): 12
 jurisdictions in 5 countries
- Three (tbc) Study Tours to Europe are being planned.
- Cooperation between FICAP, WB, KfW, India AQM program









• The first study tour to take place 4-12 November 2024 - Indian federal government, and the governments of Uttar Pradesh, Haryana, and Bihar.
